ALL Dog and small animal exhibitors will need to complete this form. These will be displayed at the fair and are required in order to receive a premium. The forms are replacing the posters and food displays that where done in the past. This can be used in your 4-H Record Book as the project page.

Instructions:

- Print the dog/small animal project description form.
- Attach a picture of you WITH your project animal (dog, cat, etc.). We want to see both the exhibitor and the animal in the picture.
- Complete the form
 - o Exhibitor name
 - Exhibitor organization (4-H club, FFA chapter, etc.)
 - Description of project: tell the fairgoers about your project in 3-4 sentences.
 Ideas for this section could be the name of your animal, years in the project, obedience levels (dogs), how you got into the project, your favorite part of the project, or any other relevant information.
 - Complete one form PER PERSON PER ANIMAL. If you are exhibiting more than one animal, you need to fill out a form for each animal!
- Return these forms to the fair office by **11 AM on Thursday** of the fair. They will be displayed throughout the duration of the fair.
- You may take your form & pictures during regular entry release time on Sunday.
 Any forms/pictures left after entry release on Sunday will be thrown away. If you cannot make it back for entry release and would like yours to be saved, contact the Dog & Small Animal Superintendent.
