ELIGIBILITY:

- Must be at least a High School Senior and 18 years of age by January 1st of the current year
- Contestants may be male or female
- Must have a genuine interest in promoting the Crawford County Fair & be an exhibitor during his/her reign
- Attend the Interview and Judging process held on the 1st Friday of November at the Crawford County Administration Building in Prairie du Chien. All applicants must attend this interview or forfeit their position in the Fair Ambassador contest.

The purpose of the Crawford County Fair Ambassador is to serve as a year around representative for the Crawford County Fair. The Fair Ambassador will fulfill the duties and strive to reach the Goals set by the Crawford County Fair Ambassador Committee. The Fair Ambassador will promote fair attendance, sponsorship of and exhibition at the fair, focusing on agriculture and youth involvement in the fair.

THESE GOALS WILL BE ACHIEVED BY:

- Attending all days of the Crawford County Fair. Ambassador will be responsible for helping in various ways including but not limited to: attending judging, Meat Animal Auction, grandstand events, etc.
- Attending community events such as the Dairy Breakfast, Community Festivals, parades and others as required by contract.
- Speak to youth groups, including but not limited to: 4-H Clubs, Scout Troops, FFA Chapters, etc.
- Organizing off season events for the Fair Ambassador, Future Fair Ambassadors and any applicable attendants
- Attend meeting required by contract
- Prepare radio spots and press releases promoting the Crawford County Fair
- Represent Crawford County in the completion for the Wisconsin Association of Fairs, Fairest of the Fairs in early January

JUDGING:

- Interviews will be held on the 2nd Friday in November at the Crawford County Administration building at 5:30 pm, unless notified of a change
- Applicants will be interviewed by a panel of Judges
- Attendants will be selected at the discretion of the Judges and the Fair Ambassador Committee

- Apply by the fourth Friday in October

Crawford County Fair Ambassador Expectations

The Crawford County Fair Ambassador Program is a professional position whom is regarded as a leader in the community. The Ambassador must possess exceptional public speaking skills, dedication, self-motivation, charisma, enthusiasm for the Crawford County Fair, and genuine interest in furthering his/her skills to better achieve these characteristics.

As the Crawford County Fair Ambassador, you serve as a fair ambassador for an entire calendar year. You are expected to fulfill certain responsibilities in this year. The following lists are requirements for being in the position:

Pre-Fair Public Service Media (Fair Ambassador):

- ❖ Radio Stations
 - WQPC- Prairie Du Chien
 - WGLR- Lancaster
 - WVRQ- Viroqua
 - WRCO- Richland Center
 - Any radio stations from La Crosse Area
- ❖ TV Stations
 - WKBT- La Crosse
 - WXOW- La Crosse

Week of Fair:

- ❖ Be present and visible the week of the Fair
- ❖ Greet visitors at the gate, animal shows, and in grandstands
- ❖ 50/50 Raffle at grandstand events
- ❖ Hand out awards at animal shows

Speaking and Presentation Events:

- ❖ Must do 5 speaking events: this will include visiting schools, 4-H Clubs, FFA and any other community organizations to promote the Fair and the Fair Ambassador Program.
- ❖ 3 Speaking Events should be at 4-H Clubs and FFA Meetings

Community Events:

- ❖ Attend 10 Community Events:
 - St. Patty's Day Parade (Prairie Du Chien)
 - Dairy Princess Crowning
 - Memorial Day Parade (Wauzeka)
 - Dairy Breakfast
 - June Dairy Days Parade (Soldiers Grove)
 - Eastman 4th of July Parade
 - Ridge and Valley Days Parade (Seneca)
 - Apple Fest Parade (Gays Mills)
 - Holiday Parade (Prairie Du Chien)
 - Ring Bells for the Salvation Army
